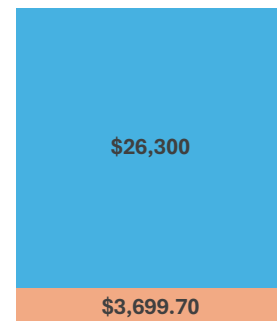

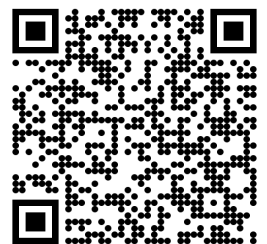

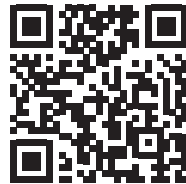
OTHER NEWS AROUND OUR COMMUNITY
