



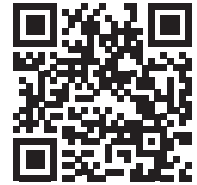

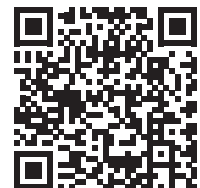

KENYA MISSION TRIP - Want to participate in the Kenya Mission Trip without leaving home? Sponsor a clean water filtration bucket for \$30. It will provide clean water for a family for up to 10 years. The filtration systems are purchased through RipplAffect and are geo tagged, so once we've handed them out in June 2026, you'll be able to see a photo of the family who received it, and track their location on the website's map. We are 96% of the way to our goal (\$7,582.26 of \$7,900). Thank you to the many generous people who have given so far!

PLAYGROUND PHASE 2 - Includes installation of a concrete apron around the playground and basic landscaping (including planting grass) to make the playground more attractive and accessible. The concrete apron has already been installed and landscaping is scheduled for later this month. Our goal to finish phase 2 is \$25,000. In March we received \$1,702.85. Thank you to the generous donors who are contributing to this project.
